THE ALDO BECKMAN MEMORIAL AWARD
CALL FOR ENTRIES

The White House Correspondents' Association is pleased to announce competition for the **Aldo Beckman Award** for presidential news coverage. The prize recognizes a correspondent who personifies the journalistic excellence as well as the personal qualities exemplified by Aldo Beckman, the award-winning correspondent of the *Chicago Tribune* and former WHCA president.

Competition is open to all journalists who cover the White House on a regular basis, or whose reporting is primarily devoted to coverage of the White House or the presidency. There is a prize of \$1,000, and it will be presented at the annual dinner of the Association at the Washington Hilton Hotel on Saturday, May 9, 2009.

The award will be based on a correspondent's reportage during the year ending December 31, 2008. Journalistic excellence will be the primary criterion. However, the judges may wish to honor an outstanding young reporter, a reporter who has demonstrated repeated excellence in White House coverage over a long period, or a reporter who personifies the human qualities exemplified by Aldo Beckman. Judges may also choose to make no award in a given year.

Guidelines for the 2009 Award

* Entrants are invited to submit a representative sample of their work for the calendar year 2008 not to exceed six articles or broadcast scripts. Online entries must be original Web content.

* Material for consideration must be submitted in triplicate. It should contain the dateline, date of publication or broadcast, name of publication or news organization, and a supervisor's certification that the nominee wrote or dictated the story. Entries may be in the form of clippings, original material, wire copy printouts, photocopies or broadcast scripts. A completed entry form must accompany each of the three copies of a story.

* Entries become the property of the White House Correspondents' Association.

* The decision of the judges on all matters relating to the award is final.

* All entries must be received at the WHCA office **no later than 5 PM, March 12, 2009.**

* Please place the name of the award on the entry envelope.
